### **Ruff Recovery**

### Autumn Awareness

#### Be Cautious of Rodenticides and Cold Weather Poisons

The use of rat and mouse poisons increase in the fall as rodents seek shelter from the cooler temperatures by attempting to move indoors. Rodenticides are highly toxic to pets and, if ingested, the results could be fatal. If you must use these products, please do so with extreme caution and put them in places inaccessible to your pets.

Many people choose fall as the time to change their car's engine coolant. Ethylene glycol-based coolants are highly toxic, so spills should be cleaned up immediately. Consider switching to propylene glycol-based coolants though they aren't completely nontoxic, they are much less toxic than other engine coolants.





#### Keep School Supplies Out of Paws' Reach

Fall is back-to-school time, and those of you with young children know that means stocking up on items like glue sticks, pencils and magic markers. Although these items are considered low toxicity to pets, gastrointestinal upset and blockages can occur if ingested. Be sure your children keep their school supplies out of your pet's reach.

#### Steer Clear of Mushrooms

Fall and spring are mushroom seasons. While 99% of mushrooms have little or no toxicity, the 1% that are highly toxic can cause life-threatening problems in pets. Since most toxic mushrooms are difficult to distinguish from nontoxic ones, the best way to prevent pets from ingesting these poisonous plants is to keep them away from areas where any mushrooms are growing.





#### Watch Out for Wildlife

Autumn is the season when snakes are preparing for hibernation, increasing the possibility of bites to those unlucky pets who find themselves in the wrong place at the wrong time. Pet parents should know what kinds of venomous snakes may be lurking in their environment—and where those snakes are most likely to be found—so pets can be kept out of those areas.





Now Offering Traditional Chinese Veterinary Medicine (TCVM)

#### What is TCVM?

Traditional Chinese Veterinary Medicine (TCVM) although relatively new to the Western world, is a medical system that has been used in China to treat humans and animals for thousands of years. TCVM is often viewed as a form of complementary therapy and is best when used in conjunction with Western Veterinary Medicine (WVM). Both TCVM and WVM have their own strengths and weaknesses. TCVM is a holistic approach that is suited to assessing the wellbeing of the whole patient, and treatments are generally non-invasive with few side effects. However, TCVM lacks the tools necessary to pinpoint illness to specific disease-causing agents like pathogenic bacteria or viruses, and treatments are better suited for chronic conditions than acute ones. On the other hand, WVM utilizes the tools of modern science to diagnose disease with great precision, however its' insistence on detailed diagnosis may come at the expense of getting the larger picture. Furthermore, while modern medicine and powerful procedures can perform miracles for trauma and acute injuries, it has little to offer chronic conditions like liver failure and atopy which can be treated effectively with acupuncture and herbal medicine. In many ways, TCVM and WVM each has what the other lacks.

Thus, the best medical system involves the integration of the two systems, so that the strengths of one can compensate for the weaknesses of the other.

### Dr. Qiang Li recalls the success of TCVM Acupuncture

"I have used acupuncture to treat three down dachshund so far at VCA over the past couple of months. All three presented as paralyzed. The first two were able to walk with only 1 session of acupuncture. The third dachshund, after pairing with Chinese herb, improved after the 3rd acupuncture treatment.

Through these cases, when owners may not financially be able to afford an MRI and surgery, there is still hope of walking normally with Traditional Chinese Veterinary Medicine."
